

Bergius Botanic Garden and the Old Orangery

Close to the University Campus and the Congress site, there is the beautiful Bergius Botanic Garden. The primary objective of the Bergius Botanic Garden is to support teaching and research about plant diversity. With a history stretching back to the 18th century, the garden is today owned and managed by the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences and Stockholm University.
